CONSTRUCTION ON NEW IQ CREDIT UNION HEADQUARTERS MAKES PROGRESS

VANCOUVER, Wash. — The highly-visible rotating iQ Credit Union time and temperature sign is temporarily on hiatus from the rooftop of its headquarters building under construction at 1313 Main Street in downtown Vancouver. Construction crews are hard at work on the building's electrical system so the sign was disconnected to ensure their safety.

Construction on the nearly 30,000 square feet building, which began in early summer, is on schedule. The general contractor, Team Construction LLC, has completed the removal of the building's former exterior as part of a complete exterior upgrade. Right now, work is also underway on an extensive seismic upgrade that includes filling the building's u-shaped columns with concrete and steel and a special fiber wrap to meet current seismic guidelines. Glass on the east, north and south sides of the building will be installed by the first of December, with work on the west side vestibule to begin shortly thereafter.

iQ Credit Union is expected to take occupancy of its new facility in second quarter of 2009.
