Alan Webb Clark County Teacher of the Year Official Rules

1. No purchase necessary. To enter, write an essay on why this teacher should be **Alan Webb's Teacher of the year** and drop, mail it to any Alan Webb Dealer or IQ credit union locations. You may also e-mail the nomination to TammyW@AlanWebbAutoGroup.com or fill out your nomination online at the www.AlanWebbAutoGroup.Com. One entry per household please. Multiple entries by a household will disqualify all entries by that household. Entries must be received by each deadline. Entries after this date are void and will not be included for consideration.
2. Winners will be selected and notified no later than June 21st. The winner will be notified 14 business days of selections
3. Four educators will be selected. Each will be recognized as Teacher of the Year at their level (one Elementary Teacher, Middle School Teacher, High School, College) in June of 2009. The committee will then begin evaluating each teacher to select one among them as Clark County Teacher of the Year. In September 2009 the finalists will be honored at a ceremony in which one will be named Clark County Teacher of the Year.
4. Eligibility: Open to all legal U.S residents of WA.
5. The entries will be evaluated by a committee of parents, business persons, administrators, and the past teacher of the Year on the following criteria: 1- Does the essay include strong examples and details that support that the teacher is the best? 2- Does the essay portray a teacher that goes above and beyond in the classroom? 3- Does the essay capture the power and value of the teacher? A committee of peers will select each teacher representative. The four finalists will be asked to serve on the 2008-2009 committee to select their predecessor. The Committee uses a weighted rubric to evaluate each essay. Essays are weighted only if it is written by a minor under 16 years of age. Weighted essays have 1 point added to each section of the rubric categories.
