


STEP 1: Get to know the coins

Color the penny brown







Although the penny is the same shape as the other coins, it is the only one that's a different color!




Color the nickel grey









Color the dime grey








Color the quarter grey







STEP 2: Get to know the one dollar bill

Color the dollar bill green








Did you know?

STEP 4: Setting goals


Is there something you really want? Maybe a new toy, video game or craft?

You can save the money you earn to buy that item!


- 1. Use the space below to draw a picture of an item you want.
- 2. Write one way you can earn money to buy this item.


We know how important it is to save our money. A piggy bank is a safe place to keep and save the money you earn.
